After School Program (ages 8-11)

The After School Program offers children a hands-on opportunity to work with the shelter animals. There are five sessions, each session includes six classes which are held on Mondays from 4:00pm-5:00pm.

Junior Board Representative (High School)

Teens have the opportunity to join our Junior Board! Junior Board Representatives meet once a month and are responsible for developing/implementing fundraisers for NAHS at their school, extracurricular activities or other avenues. The Junior Board helps generate donations and spread awareness for adoption.

Birthday Party Coordinator (ages 16+)

Work with children and animals as a party coordinator who educates through a shelter tour and humane themed crafts. Parties normally held on Saturdays for 2 hours.

Tours & Presentations (all ages)

NAHS offers educational behind-the-scenes tours of our shelter to groups up to 15 people. Each in-person tour requires a \$50 monetary donation. NAHS also offers educational presentations on a variety of topics for schools, scout groups or any members of the community.

Girl Scout & Boy Scout Patch Program (all ages)

At each level, scouts do a number of fun educational activities to learn about pets and our shelter. Pre-activities are available to troop leaders in advance for the scouts to complete, and then all lessons are tied together with an educational shelter tour! Tours are by appointment only.

We offer seasonal internships working with children and animals that includes creating lesson plans, networking with other animal-related organizations, and learning about shelter operations. Internships are offered for college credit.

Jr. Camp Counselors / Humane Education Assistant (ages 13+)

A great opportunity for teens who want to become a teacher or work with animals, as he or she will help create and execute lesson plans for our summer camps and other educational programs.
