The Naperville Area Humane Society's Summer Camp program educates children and teaches empathy to the next generation of animal advocates.

Internship responsibilities include assistance with implementation of the *Animals and Us* Summer Day Camp for children. Interns will assist with daily preparations, supervise children, lead camp activities, and develop and present humane education programs. Students will have the opportunity to participate in other aspects of the humane society, such as animal care, adoptions, and observation of dog temperament testing.
